

Bed and board and traveling details

The participating group is expected to be accommodated in Youth Hostel and host families .All adult members will stay at the youth hostel and all children will stay in the Host families.

All adult members will stay at the Youth hostel at National Bal Bhawan, where they can mutually form a friendly relationship. Hostel is located in the heart of city and is one of the important venues of the festival.

Those participating groups from overseas are not charged for their accommodation (bed and board) during their stay and also the traveling expenses from International Airport New Delhi to Youth Hostel/Host families and back.

Air/Rail Fares Will Be Borne By The Participants/ Institutions. The Nearest International Airport Is Indira Gandhi International Airport, New Delhi.

Participants Have To Make Arrangements Up to Delhi & Back Including Air Fare, Visa Charges, And Airport Tax & Personal Insurance.

Each participating group to be accompanied by a person who can speak English.

Hosting families are the students of Ryan International Schools. All Host families are personally selected by the members of Ryan Foundation. All the selected families have a clean and hygienic living space for the students, clean drinking water, transportation and great food facilities.

2 students will stay in 1 host family .Once we receive your application form; we will request you to pair up 2 students for 1 family. Through this exchange they will be able to see India more closely and experience true Indian Hospitality.

Once we receive your final list ,we will send you the address ,phone number and e-mail addresses of all host families 1 month in advance ,so that your children can contact there host families in advance and can plan what they want to do before the festival starts.

Teams only with children can opt for the host family stays.

Please note the Hostel is in National Bal Bhawan, which is located in the heart of New Delhi. This is also the most important venue of the festival, so you don't have to travel at all. National Bal Bhawan has 2 open Air Auditoriums, 1 indoor auditorium, huge grounds, 3 Museums and a lot of other facilities.
