

General Rules:

Article 1

Each participating group is to present a performance for children, and /or by the children. The group can give the performance in its own native language. The length of it must be less than forty minutes.

Article 2

The participating groups that come from abroad will be accommodated (bed and board) free of charge during their stay. Free accommodation will be limited to twelve persons for each group. Each group is requested to accompany a person or persons who can speak English.

Article 3

Persons who accompany the participating group over and above those actually, taking part, or in the excess of the twelve persons, for whom free accommodation is provided, may be asked to pay the charge for accommodation. And those who want to prolong their stay after the festival will also be charged for their accommodation.

Article 4

The groups are advised to bring with them essential setting and / or special properties and accessories for their performance.

Article 5

For publicity purpose, each group is expected to obtain authorization for live or recoded radio / television / internet transmission of the extract(s) or the whole of their performance.

Article 6

Each group will supply to the organizer, as soon as possible, the information and documents that are requested in questionnaires and circulars. These responses must be written in English.

Article 7

The festival is to be held as a festival where no ranking is accorded, so that participants may achieve mutual understanding and friendship among themselves.

Article 8

Each participating group is required to bring their National Flag 36 inches X 24 inches for Opening ceremony and soil / earth for the closing ceremony.

Article 9

At the beginning of all performances there will be one minute Christian prayer for the well being of all the participants. We respect all religions and faiths and look forward to participants from across globe.

Article 10

Kindly note if any information like name, age and gender is incomplete on the application form, the same will be printed on the festival brochure and it may also lead to confusion at the time of checking in at the hostel.

Article 11

A detailed list of facilities available in the hostel will be send to you by end of August 2009.

Article 12

Kindly avoid extremely short clothes to avoid any misconduct and respect the sensibilities of other visiting countries during the festival.
